Becoming A Firewise Community

Most of us feel lucky to live in this beautiful corner of California. Except for fire danger. Now there is something we can do about that.

If most of the 275+ households that live in Vista Verde-Los Trancos Woods do some fuel reduction and home hardening, and document it, we can qualify as a Firewise USA Site. Woodside Fire Marshal Don Bullard is helping a neighborhood committee to organize this effort. The first step is to assess our overall wildfire risk by asking each household to fill out a questionnaire about their property. Soon you will receive an email with step-
