Are We Prepared? Are You Prepared?

On Saturday, March 23, 2019, the San Mateo County Office of Emergency Service - as part of the countywide Emergency Preparedness Drill - sent out several TEST alerts about a “possible” evacuation. **What if you did not receive these alerts!?** In a REAL emergency, this could mean that you would not receive potentially life saving information about evacuation orders and which evacuation route to take. We are all in this together, and it would be heartbreaking to leave anyone behind. It could also endanger those who get these alerts, who might then delay their departure to warn neighbors that they need to evacuate. We may only get a 5 minute warning.

Think back to Saturday, March 23rd. If you did not get a notification by text, phone, and email, you can remedy that. For text and email, register with SMCAAlert.info. It only takes about 5 minutes which may be all the time you get to evacuate. If you did not get a phone call, email Chris at cmpaprcka@gmail.com and let him know with your name, address and phone number.

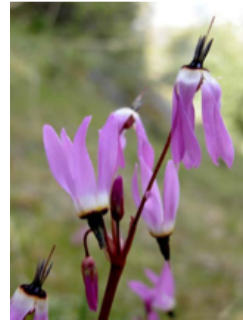
Common Star Lily
